CROATIA CRUISE FAQS

What are the differences in itinerary for each cruise?

The departure points for each cruise are detailed on page 1 of this document.

There are very few differences in itinerary for each cruise. The main difference is that only those cruising on MS Eden will visit Makarska. The other boats will exclude Makarska and spend more time at the other ports of call. The cruise schedules have been created with Summer 16 customer feedback in mind.

Also, due to the flying schedules, those cruising from Dubrovnik with a Sunday departure will spend their 7th night at Hotel Croatia at the end of the cruise, as well as a further 7 nights if opting for Cruise and Stay.

What style of dining is it during the cruise?

During the cruise, it is á la carte dining but these are set meals. Lunch on the 3^* plus and 4^* boats consist of 3 courses, and lunch on the 4^* plus boats consist of 4 courses.

There is a free seating arrangement and tables are often shared with other passengers.

What meals are included?

Whilst on the cruise, only breakfast and lunch are included. If choosing a Cruise and Stay option, breakfast and dinner will be included during the hotel stay.

Where does the customer eat their dinner whilst on the cruise?

The boat docks at a different harbour every afternoon. This allows the guests to explore the local area and dine at a restaurant of their choice on an evening.

Is it possible to purchase evening meals on the boat?

Evening meals are available to purchase on the boat but there should be a minimum of 10 persons, however, there is no real need for this because in each port there are plenty of great dining options.

Does the boat sale through the night?

No, the boat docks at a different harbour every afternoon and sets sail again the next morning.

When is the bar open? What types of drinks are available?

The on board bar is open between 12pm and 12am. Both local and international drinks are available.

How do guests pay for their drinks?

Drinks paid for in cash at the end of the cruise. No credit cards are accepted.

Are any excursions, escorted tours or tickets etc. included in the price?

No, however, there is a dedicated Cruise Manager on board for the duration of the cruise to offer expert advice and recommendations of the local area.

Are there ramps and lifts on board?

There are ramps on board but no lifts between the floors.

Will all passengers speak English?

Not necessarily, the boats often consist of guests with mixed nationalities.

Is there an entertainment programme on the boat?

No. Guests can spend their free time on the boat on the sundeck and swimming in the ocean during swim-stops.

Are there snorkel masks for guests to use on board?

This is not guaranteed but snorkel masks are available to buy in each port.

How many sun loungers are on board?

There are 12 sun loungers on board, along with tables and chairs on the spacious sun deck.

Are beach towels available?

Beach towels are €5 to hire and can only be changed once or twice a week.

What is the crew to passenger ratio on each cruise?

About 1:6. Each boat sails with about 40 guests.

Are *Jet2holidays* customers required to pay Tourists Tax and Port Tax whilst on board.

No, these taxes are included in the price.

What country are the cruise boats registered to? Croatia.

Is there a weight and/or size limit to the luggage guests are able to bring on board and is there a suitable place to store suitcases?

There is no size or weight limit. What cannot be stored in the cabin, the crew will put in the boat storage.

Do guests have access to clothes washing facilities either on board or at the points of call?

There are no washing facilities on board and they don't spend enough time at the ports of call.

Are the guests required to tip?

Yes, the customers are expected to tip. It is done at the end of the cruise and the amount is at their own discretion. About 25 € per cabin for the crew and 15 € per cabin for the cruise manager is advised.

What time are guests required to vacate the boat on the last day? Guests are require to vacate the boat after breakfast. If there is a long period of time between vacating the boat and the customer's flight

period of time between vacating the boat and the customer's flight that day, the cruise staff are able to securely store luggage before the customer is picked up for their transfer later that day, allowing customers to explore their departure point (either Split or Dubrovnik).

I'm having availability issues on the Jet2holidays website.

If you are having availability issues, please make sure you incorporate the following:

- · Search for Sunday departure for cruises departing from Split.
- Search for Saturday or Sunday departure for cruises departing from Split.
- Search for 7 nights if in need of the Cruise Only option.
- Search for 14 nights if in need of the Cruise and Stay option (make sure the cruise you're searching for is the 'And Stay' option.

Please note: for S17, cruises sailing from Split with flights departing from Edinburgh and London Stansted are not available due to the flying schedule. Suggest a cruise sailing from Dubrovnik as an alternative.
